

LUCKY BONUS DRAW KENO

Introduction

LUCKY BONUS DRAW KENO is a Keno game with 80 numbers to choose from and 20 numbers randomly drawn at every round. You may select between 2 to 10 numbers. From the 20 numbers drawn, the last number drawn is the number representing the Golden Coin that triggers the bonus draw with a X5 multiplier.

How to Bet

Choose between 2 to 10 numbers in the 80 numbers grid. Press on a desired number on the grid to select it. The color of the number on the grid will change to a different color to show that the number has been selected. To unselect a number, press on a selected number. You may also press and drag to select multiples numbers.

Stakes

Display the current stake amount for the round.

Press the minus button (-) to decrease the stake amount for the next round.

Press the plus button (+) to increase the stake amount for the next round.

Clear All

Clear all selected numbers from the grid.

Clear Last

Clear last selected number from the grid.

Lucky Dip

Randomly select numbers from the grid. The number in the Lucky Dip field indicates the selection of the numbers (from 2 to 10).

Press the minus button (-) to decrease the selection of the numbers.

Press the plus button (+) to increase the selection of the numbers.

Previous selection

Allows to cycle through the previous played numbers selection.

Press the back arrow to go back to the previous played numbers selection.

Press the forward arrow to go to the next played numbers selection.

Play

Press to start the game.



Press to access the options menu.



Enable or disable auto play.



Enable or disable sounds or background music.



Display game's rules.

Drawing Numbers

Once the numbers have been selected, press on Play to start the game. The game will randomly draw 20 numbers out of the 80 numbers.

When the drawn number lands on a number on the grid that has not been selected, the number on the grid will change to a distinct colour. If the drawn number lands on a selected number, the number will change to a different colour than previously.

Lucky Bonus Draw Number

At the end of the regular 20 numbers draw, if your selected numbers match sufficient numbers, it will register as a win and you will receive a payment according to the payable.

The last drawn number (the 20th ball) is always the Golden Coin number. If the Golden Coin number lands on one of your selected numbers, it will automatically trigger a bonus event which

will see the game draw an additional 5 random numbers giving you a chance to match additional numbers from your numbers pick selection. All winnings from bonus draw are paid X5.

How to Win

Winnings are paid accordingly to the paytable and depends on how many numbers you have selected and how many numbers matched. Winnings payout is indicated in the paytable and will adjust accordingly based on the numbers selection and the stake amount.

The prizes are paid in accordance with the payout table available on the game interface.

Return to Player

The odds of getting a particular outcome are always the same at the start of every game. The odds do not vary based on prior outcomes, bet size, balance size, numbers picked, time of day, day of the week, etc. For example, if the top award is won on a given play of the game, the chances of winning the top award on the next play are exactly the same. Likewise, prior losses do not change future odds.

The theoretical average return to player (RTP) is between 92.09% and 96.04% depending on how many numbers are picked. This RTP represents the long- term expected payback of the game which has been calculated by an independent testing company. Malfunction Voids all pays and plays. Any game in progress for more than 35 days will be cancelled, and the corresponding bet will be refunded.
